# Increase In Dues and The Lifetime Membership Effective January 1st, 2015

The Budget Deficit Committee explored a number of options to eliminate the current deficit and future shortfalls as expenses grow and membership declines. We have raised the dues once in over thirty years of our existence. The last increase in dues went from \$8 a year to \$10 starting January 2004. The vote to change the by-laws dues payment and the lifetime membership was approved at the June Board Meeting.

The dues will increase to \$15/year and a Lifetime Membership will increase to \$150 effective for all payments made after January 1, 2015.




